Establishment of Mere Ghar ki Shala

In 20 villages of the project area, my home school was established in each village for the study and teaching of children, for this, education volunteers were selected from each village and they were trained for their capacity building. The schools and Anganwadis which were closed during Kovid-19 for education, after that a school was



established in my house in the village by the education volunteer of the village for their education. In which the furniture table chair, black board, chalk, auxiliary study material, chart, rolling board, seating arrangement etc. Hindi, Mathematics, Science, Geography etc. subjects are to be taught to the children in every village in the morning and evening by the Education Volunteer. Will give to the organization in the village meeting. This is how my home school was established in every village And following the rules of Kovid-19 along with the local people, you were requested to send the children to school.

Capacity building and training of education volunteers and community members

Training was organized to enhance the capacity of education volunteers and community members of the project area. They were told



to continue their studies and teaching, as well as how to explain different subjects like language, mathematics, science, environment etc. in an easy way, it was told in the training.

Community members were given this training on how they can help education volunteers in their children's studies. And how to teach children at home, many entertaining ways and methods of learning language, maths



through games were told. In this training, education volunteers were given some technical information for reporting and progress assessment of the work done by them. So that they submit weekly and monthly reports to the organization and their work is inspected by the organization from time to time. And evaluation will be done. Community members will also participate in this.

Community awareness meetings on drop out reduction in 16 villages

In 16 villages of the project area, meetings were organized by the organization to make the community aware of the school dropout children, in which discussions were held to tell people about the



school dropout children and to send them to school and to



continue their studies regularly.

Neither Anganwadis nor schools opened in the villages during Kovid-19, but before that many children did not go to school, they either went to

work with their parents. Or they used to take care of their younger brothers and sisters. Some children used to migrate along with their parents, so the education of such children was left midway. How to continue the education of these children, Right to Education Act, 14 years Information about compulsory free education for children, Child Labor Prohibition Act etc. was given in every village meeting and school dropouts were identified and meetings were held with government school teachers for their regular studies.

Dry Ration Distribution to Vulnerable Families

Dry ration was distributed to the economically weaker families of the project area by the project, in which edible oil, spices, pulses, rice, tea leaves, sugar, flour etc. were provided, so that these families got food security. Due to lack of purchasing power of the

people, such families were identified by the project. And dry ration was distributed only to the needy families, as well as continuous efforts were made by the organization to connect these families with the government's free ration scheme and they were provided ration from the government.



National Women's day Celebration

National Women's Day celebration was organized with the women of the project area, in which information about National Women's Day was given and the rights of women were



told. Information was given about the laws made in the interest of women, under this, information was given about the Equal Wages Act, Prevention of Women's Violence Act, Women's Domestic Violence Act, laws made for women at workplace, dowry and other social laws. Along with this, information about the facilities and schemes provided by the Department of Women and Child Development to women and adolescent girls was given to Anganwadi centers. Women also expressed their views in this function.
