1. Anemia Free India

two-day anemia-free India training was organized by Gramin **Vikas** Sanstha Chicholi. in which a total of 59 participants were present, Anita Yadav, the source of the twoday training, and



Mr. Anil Bhusari, director of GVS, inaugurated the training by lighting the lamp in the presence of the participants. It was told in



the training that anemia occurs when there is a decrease in the level of

hemoglobin according to age and gender. Anemia leads to ill health, economic loss and increased social burden.

Anemia can be diagnosed by assessing the level of hemoglobin (Hb) in the blood and based on clinical symptoms. Anemia can be caused by nutritional deficiencies, infections, and genetic diseases, which can lead to reproductive problems, excessive destruction of red blood cells, or anemia. Disease diagnosis of anemia- Iron folic acid supplements prevent anemia.

2. Biodynamic Jevic Training

In today's present environment, every person wants to complete the economic competition fast. In the same episode, farmers are also involved in making full use of chemical fertilizers and pesticides for higher production. And it is engaged in making its fertile land barren, production will be available, but in the future, mankind will have to face the risk of innumerable diseases and economic harvests.



Keeping this in mind, GVS

organized Biodynamic Organic Training to change agriculture practice and process keeping human health in mind, increase the fertility of agricultural land and reduce the cost of agriculture. In which 350 participants took part.

Before composting, a 10X20 shady pavilion is prepared.

Biodynamic process bed construction on 5X20 on normal ground Which is made up to a height of 5 feet by mixing green leaves, green grass, half trolley cow dung and 1 trolley garbage straw on



the surface of the land, it is smeared with cow dung, after that about 15 holes are made in it, in which Supa biodynamic manure culture 1 kg The mixture is prepared and closed by pouring the solution into the holes made. Water sprinkling is also done every week as per requirement. The process of composting is completed within 55 to 60 days. After this, this manure is kept in a shady place in a plastic bag. and ready for use in agriculture.

3. Capacity Building & Training Education Volunteers

During the Covid-19 epidemic, children were suddenly deprived of education activities. During that time the children went on migration with their parents, some got engaged in animal grazing, some got engaged in other works, as a result they got

from away education. their attachment and inclination decreased. reeducation in children from the point of view of making study interesting. To special conduct classes 20 in villages of Chicholi District



Panchayat by Gramin Vikas Sanstha through Covid Relief Fund, by selecting 12th pass education volunteers at the village level, they are given primary, Its quality quarterly training was conducted in which a total of 25 participants were trained by the resource persons of Education Volunteers. Moral education and how

children are taught through games and sports.



4. Divyaang Chetana Baithak

A three-day Divyang Chetna meeting was organized by the Gramin Vikas Sanstha for the Divyangians of the project area, in which the government has recognized 21 types of disabilities, the livelihood of the Divyangians related to them, their living, upbringing, equality in the society, ending non-equality. To remove from Divyangjan. uncomfortable behavior And detailed information was given by organizing various types of government schemes on the rights and entitlements of disabled people, capacity building skills, increasing disabled consciousness, in which a total of 31 participants participated.

Society's sense of tolerance towards the disabled should not be an unequal thinking; Society should also behave like normal people and that too should not feel uncomfortable in itself. Capacity has been developed regarding the eligibility and rights of the Divyangjan in various public welfare schemes of the state and central government. An action plan has to be prepared to motivate the Divyangs to take advantage and take initiative for livelihood according to their skills and abilities.

6. Pesa Act Gram Sabha Empowerment

One day training was organized in 20 villages by Gramin Vikas

Sanstha on **Panchayat Bylaws** (Extension to Scheduled **PESA** Areas) Rules, 2022 Gram Sabha **Empowerment** in each village. 917 participants from 20 villages



were trained in the training. Since the implementation of this



PESA Act 1996, the Madhya Pradesh government has made policy and rules and it was considered applicable from November 14, 2022, from the date of publication in the gazette. Under the PESA Act, the Gram Sabha adjacent to the boundary of its Gram Panchayat, mineral, secondary wealth, forest produce, through the Gram Sabha, the right of tax collection has been obtained from

the people who come for the work of public welfare, the

residents, traders, moneylenders, vendors, traders and others, in connection with which the capacity of the Gram Sabha has been built.

In relation to the use of the powers given to the Gram Sabha and efforts with positive impact, information about PESA



rules was given. Detailed information was provided regarding the use of PESA law for the strengthening and empowerment of the Gram Sabha at the local level. And the participants were also explained that this law should not be misused. Nor should there be differences of opinion with the administration, the Gram Sabha has every right to earn its own income at the local level, to remove social evils and also to change them. They also have the right to act according to their traditions and natural protection and are free to act on the basis of their activities and beliefs.



7. Prakratik Jevik Kheti Training

Natural organic farming training in 20 villages of Chicholi block by Rural Development Institute, Chicholi District Betul, going to each village, source persons gave detailed information about



natural organic farming from 11 January 2023 to 27 January 2023, in which 926 participants from 20 villages Get trained

Due to the adverse effects of chemical fertilizers used on agriculture in the present times, the farmers were informed about the techniques of natural farming in order to slowly move them towards organic farming. Gave information about Jeev Amrit, Beej Amrit, Supa Biodynamic Fertilizer etc.



8. Village Level Organic Training

Organic training in 20 villages of Chicholi block by Gramin Vikas Sanstha, Chicholi District, Betul. Source persons went to each village and gave detailed information about village level organic farming, in which training was given to 720 participants from 20



villages.

That the community and the farmer can easily do organic farming from a native cow in a short time with low cost. In which the fertilizer power of the land will gradually increase and the production will also increase. organic farming. That's why the mentality of the farmers was increased in promoting organic farming.
